Frequently Asked Questions

When are the 2017 Fees due?

The due date for 2017 fees is **31 October, 2016** unless you have entered into an instalment agreement to pay fees over a 12 month period, running from the 1 November, 2016 to 31 October, 2017.

Accounts paid in full by the 31 October, 2016 will attract a 5% settlement discount.

What methods of payment do you offer?

Payments can be made by Direct Debit from a credit card or bank account, BPAY, EFT or Cash.

- For direct debit payment arrangements please complete the Direct Debit Request Form included with your fee account and return in the enclosed reply paid envelope.
- For all other payment arrangements please advise the Family Liaison Officer in writing or email at vmuldrew@mercedes.catholic.edu.au and include the preferred payment method, proposed payment amount, frequency (weekly, fortnightly or monthly) and date of payment commencement.

When are Direct Debits processed?

The Direct Debit Request form allows you to nominate monthly, fortnightly or weekly instalments and all arrangements are processed on Fridays only.

For monthly instalments you may request to pay on a particular date i.e. the 21st of each month, and we will process your instalment on the closest Friday following that date.

What if I already have a Direct Debit Request in place for 2016?

Payment arrangements are only valid for a 12 month period and are therefore reviewed annually. It is the College expectation that you complete a new Direct Debit Form to ensure instalments are kept up to date.

What is my BPay Reference Number?

If you choose to pay your account using the BPay method and your unique BPay Reference Number does not display on your statement, please contact the Finance Office on 08 83723221 for assistance.

What reference should I use when paying by EFT?

If you choose to remit fees using the EFT method please use your Account ID Number as the reference.

How is the instalment guide at the bottom of my Statement calculated?

Instalments per the example below are calculated over a 12 month period from the 1 November, 2016 to 31 October, 2017 and are used as a guide to ensure payment arrangements clear your account by 31 October, 2017.

Please note that the instalment guide will also include any outstanding fees from 2016.

Invoices are due and payable either by the due date displayed or by agreed Payment Instalments. For information purposes to clear your account by the 31 October 2017 you would be required to commit to the following instalments:

Weekly instalments of \$ 342.71 , or Fortnightly Instalments of \$ 616.87 , or Monthly Instalments of \$1542.16

What is my "Brought Forward" balance?

The brought forward balance on this statement displays 2016 fees that are due to be cleared by the 31 October, 2016 and may also include charges for extra-curricular activities such as sport or music.
