















Subject and Pathway Information Sessions

Gleeson Theatre

Discover your future through a series of informative presentations about the VET Programme, SACE, and IB Diploma pathways, and gain valuable insights into how to shape your senior school experience.

Session 1

5.30pm - 6.00pm

VET Information Session

Discover the Vocational Education and Training (VET) options available for Senior students to undertake in conjunction with SACE.

We will explain how VET can contribute to SACE completion and ATAR calculation, the different types of VET programmes (including government-funded and fee-paying options), and the industries where VET pathways are commonly pursued.

Attendees will hear about course eligibility, the application process, and how VET supports practical, skills-based learning aligned with student interests and future employment opportunities.

Session 2

6.15pm - 6.45pm

Year 10 into Year 11 Subject Information Session

Take a deep dive into the two Senior School pathways available at Mercedes College as facilitators give a comprehensive overview of the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme and South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).

Learn about subject selection requirements, the key differences between the IB Diploma and SACE, and how to best align subject choices with future goals.

This session will also explore tertiary entry pathways, VET options, and how to make informed decisions based on student interests, strengths, and learning styles.

Session 3

7.00pm - 7.45pm

Year 11 into Year 12 SACE/IB Subject Information Session

Explore the key considerations for subject selection in Year 12, and how ATARs are calculated.

Attendees will receive practical advice on selecting SACE subjects that align with university pre-requisites and career goals, and learn how to understand adjustment factors and scaling.

Facilitators will also provide Insights into alternate pathways such as VET, apprenticeships, and foundation studies.

Year 11 IB Diploma students will explore their options for Year 12, transitioning to SACE or gaining a stronger understanding of the structure of the second year of the Diploma.

The second part of this session also outlines the benefits of the IB's academic rigour, its focus on critical thinking, and how it supports strong transitions into university study both in Australia and internationally.
